

## July Ride Schedule

### **Saturday, July 1st, 9 am-43 miles/10:30 am-20+ miles**---Alliance – Louisville Ride---

Meet at the parking lot next to the University of Mount Union football stadium located at about 656 Hartshorn Street in Alliance at 9am for the 43-mile ride. (Directions: Exit the SR 62 hi-way from Canton onto the Alliance/State St./University of Mount Union exit. Turn right and go 2.5 - 3 miles, passing Giant Eagle, then Lavery Chevrolet on your right. At the top of the hill just past Lavery's, turn left at the blinker light, Rockhill Ave; then turn right at the very first street, Hartshorn St. Proceed a short distance on Hartshorn until it dead ends next to the stadium and turn left into the parking lot.) We will **pick up the 20+ mile riders at St. Joseph's Church in Maximo at approximately 10:30 am.** (Directions: Take the Beech Street exit off Rt. 62. After about 1.5 miles turn right just past the RR tracks /Beech Creek Botanical Garden/Butterfly House. Proceed to St Joseph's Church at the blinker light at the next intersection. Alternatively, you could come all the way across Easton St from North Canton (turn left where Meese St intersects) and keep going to the blinker light/church in "downtown" Maximo. Park in the north end of the lot behind the school rather than in front of the church entrance.) This is a rural ride from Alliance into Louisville. We will stop in Louisville for lunch at Grinder's.
